- 1. What are some of the main points of difference in the Old Testament Day of Atonement & in the New Testament Atonement of the Savior who Paul referred to? Heb 9:7-8, 25-26, 10:4; Rom 5:11.
- 2. Romans 3:25..."To be a propitiation" = Hilasterion = Mercy Seat. "Sprinkled with atoning blood on the day of atonement" Lev 16:14. What does Hebrews 9:12 explain about His "Own Blood" 1 Pet 2:24.
- 3. From Romans 3:25, think about what is different between "Faith in His blood" for the atonement of the soul (Lev 17:11) and faith (of touch) "in His virtue" for physical healing Luke 6:19.

He will come to Receive,	Luke 21:25-28
He is coming to Reign!	Revelation 19:11-21

4. At the second coming of Christ, in the day of the great tribulation after the rapture, Israel's prophesied atonement in her Messiah will take place. Psalm 50:5,6; Rom 11:26-27; Zech 13:1, 12:10. Consider how Christ's atonement "Takes away the sin of the world" John 1:29, Heb 9:25,26,28.
